Earl Bud Lee after four+ decades Earl is still going strong, writing songs recorded by George Strait, Blake Shelton, Alison Krauss and more. His first being the ever popular "Friends In Low Places" made popular by Garth Brooks.

Greg Crowe was raised in the heart of the Mississippi Delta and brings a compelling blend of blues, rock and country to the stage. Crowe is a BMI award winning songwriter whose credits include artists such as Montgomery Gentry, Sammy Kershaw, Adam Gregory, Will Hoge, Chuck Mead, Lonestar and many more.

Dave Gibson is the former front man of the Gibson/Miller Band and wrote number one hits and chart-toppers recorded by Alabama, Confederate Railroad, Montgomery Gentry, Tanya Tucker, Pam Tillis, Joe Diffie and Conway Twitty.

Becky Hobbs has recorded seven studio albums, and has charted multiple singles on the Billboard Hot Country Songs charts, including "Let's Get Over Them Together", a duet with Moe Bandy.

Justin Dukes is originally from Vidalia, GA, Justin has opened with many artists such as Vince Gill, Charlie Daniels, Shenandoah, Luke Combs, Carly Pearce, Randy Houser and many more.

Emma Zinck is pursuing her dream of being a songwriter and artist. She currently plays music full-time in Nashville while recording in the studio with Grammy Award winning producer Blake Chancey.

Sean Patrick McCarthy is the founder, front man, and lead vocalist of southern coastal group Sean McCarthy Band. In addition to being the founding member, McCarthy is also credited as a songwriter, producer and record label head.

Chancie Neal from Calhoun, Louisiana is a platinum-selling songwriter who also holds the record as the youngest World Champion Barrel Racer. Her 2019 single, "Rodeo Money", tells the story of her winning ways on the rodeo circuit as a kid while showcasing her musical talent as an adult.

Pete Sallis is a Grammy nominated songwriter who's written for Ronnie Dunn, Bucky Covington, and the hit single "Shut Up & Fish" by Maddie & Tae.

Mark Sherill has cuts with George Jones, Kenny Rogers, Johnny Cash, Hoyt Axton, Tanya Tucker, and Lacey J. Dalton, just to name a few. Mark wrote "O' Red", recorded by George Jones and more recently, Blake Shelton.

Trey Teem has won the Nash Next Middle Georgia competition two years in a row. Trey is now "living the dream", in Nashville collaborating with some of the best songwriters in the business.

Roz of the Curves is a Canadian country singer-songwriter who now calls Nashville, TN home. Roz did not grow up with country music, so her sound is a fun blend of her favorite elements from pop, rock and R&B all mixed together with a country twist.
